- Resistance
  - Job replacement
  - Lack of familiarity
  - Change fatigue
  - Perceived loss of control
- Address it with
  - Education & Training
  - Transparency
  - Involve the Team







# Challenges of GenAl and Scrum

- Alignment with Scrum values and principles
  - Human-centricity
  - Maintaining transparency
  - Preserving adaptability
  - Team ownership
- Address it with
  - Decision-support, not decisionmaking
  - Maintain the human element
  - Enhance AI transparency






# Challenges of GenAl and Scrum

- Data privacy and security concerns
  - Handling sensitive data
  - Compliance with regulations
  - Security risks
  - Data integrity
- Address it with
  - Data security protocols
  - Regular reviews and audits
  - Limit data access
  - Maintain data transparency

- Properly use Scrum
- Help teams with continuous, just-in-time coaching support
- Help product owners do their jobs more effectively
- Then ChatGPT (2022)
  - Take complex tasks and make them easy.







#### Hard Work Sierra Agility Makes Easier...

- How to be an effective Scrum Master
- How to be an effective Product Owner
- Ineffective backlog item slicing
- No product goals and unclear product strategies
- Poorly written sprint goals
- Time intensive acceptance criteria writing
- Over-planning the Sprint
- Unidentified dependencies between backlog items
